



## Impact of Global Warming in Indonesia

- Changes in seasons and rainfall
- More extreme weather events
- Rises in sea levels
- Warmer oceans





### **Impact on People**

- Livelihoods and poverty
- Food security and malnutrition
- Less water, dirty water
- Damage to health





## **Adaptation Action**

- Agricultural Revolution
- Coastal zone management protect, accommodate & retreat
- Integrated water management
- Fighting disease
- Disaster risk reduction
- Climate proofing development plans and budgets





- Climate change investment = avoid diversion of resources
- Energy policies = expanding access to poor communities
- Pro-poor fiscal policies, targeted subsidies, etc.
- Enabling environment for micro-credit, microinsurance
- Influx of carbon financing => adaptation and poverty reduction
